

The Council of First Lutheran Church met **Tuesday**, **June 18**, **2019**. The highlights of the meeting were as follows:

- Council continues to review the book <u>Ask, Thank, Tell</u> to assist us in preparing for our next Stewardship Campaign.
- The roof repair is complete except for the fascia repair. Thanks to Lee Knop and Gary Johnson for the hard work and dedication to First Lutheran Church!
- The financial status of the church continues to look extremely favorable.
- At the conclusion of the month of June, we will recalculate our Benevolence pledge and update the amount that we owe to the Synod. We will continue to review our benevolence on a quarterly basis.
- Pastor Kristine has been keeping very busy with a number of activities including weddings, Bible study and preparation for the VBS program.
- The Children's School has vacated their space, and Weight Watchers are moving to a consolidated location in the city of Sioux City.
- Preparations are being made for the installation of Lorna Halaas as Bishop on August 17th. It will be held at First Lutheran Church.
- Numerous projects to enhance the Worship experience and the appearance of the facility will be completed in the next two months. Be on the lookout for a newly improved and refreshed narthex, Fireside Room and North lobby. Memorial and undesignated funds will cover the expense of these improvements.
